### **Notes:**

1. Students admitted in AY 2026-27 will pay a tuition fee of 2,91,500/- per Semester in AY 2026-27. In subsequent years (AY 2027-28, 2028-29 etc.), tuition fee will increase @5% every year in INR for 2026-27 batch students (unless the government announces any new levy/tax, which will be passed onto all existing students irrespective of their year of entry). In addition, hostel fee will be increased every year.
2. Additional fees will also apply, should a student registers for practice school in a semester (i.e. 35% of the semester fee of the previous academic year in INR).
3. For some specific programmes requiring special treatment, fees and mode of their payment will be determined by the Vice-Chancellor in consultation with the Chancellor.
